## URA headquarters to be opened in July

The 22-storey Uganda Revenue Authority (URA) headquarters at Nakawa Kampala is expected to be ready by July. According Ian Rumanyika, URA's manager for public and corporate affairs, some officers are expected to move into the building by then.

The sh114.85b facility will accommodate most of the URA

operations that are scattered around the city and the institution's rent bill is expected to fall.

Currently, the structure is undergoing dressing and installation of electronic systems, elevators, IT systems and tiles. Once complete, URA will focus on construction of upcountry offices for further reduction in rent expenses.
